Yes, Santa came early for me and that guy had a nice big turkey on me for Christmas. So get those cars going and on the road my friends, you never know what might turn up!




ALVIN SUEMATSU, #256

trans' and narrowed 9". He also has this '40 pick-up he found in a farm field.






NELSON CORDEN, #294, KAHULUI, MAUI.


DAVE LOOPER #031 HEMET CA





JOHN ARSENIAN #438 OXFORD CT





STEVE WALCZAK #429 HILTON NY



TERRY RAY #252 IDAHO FALLS ID.



BOB WARD #410 ANCASTER ONT' CANADA








TERRY CROWELL #426 MEMPHIS TN.

The chassis is from an '84 Nissan pick-up, it now has Mustang independent front end and a '57 Olds' rear with 4:11 gears, posi' and Strange


axles, the narrowed housing is held in place by coil-overs and SS 4-link set up.






Trans is a Turbo 350 with manual valve body. Interior has Recaro power, heated seats, overhead stereo system, SW gauges and home made air conditioning.






