





I have enclosed pictures of my "41" tudor. Actually the body is a '39, the nose is a '41 and the hood is a '40. The Willys was originally built in the early '80's by Bud Rothwell and Steve Simmons from Grant's Pass, Oregon. In the years before I got it there had been both a 6-71 blown big block and a 6-71 blown small block as power.


I aquired the car from Bud in 1986 after burnt wiring and a crunching episode with a tow truck disheartened him. There was no motor or trans' but I didn't care; that was the easy part. I built a balanced 327 with forged flat tops, big chamber 1.94,s and a 280 magnum cam from Competition




little B&M unit with a 750 Holley sits on top. I scrounged up a Turbo 400 and addded a shift kit and 3200 stall speed converter, hooked it all to the Nova 10 bolt and I was ready to go. Whoops, forgot the burnt wiring. Alot of help from wiring wizard Jerry Hoskins and now I was really ready.

The car drives great thanks to a Camaro front clip with power assisted disc brakes. A tilt column lets me squeeze in under the 4½" chopped top.

Future plans include a new interior, '51 Ford sideview mirrors,
stock fenders, Halibrands, new paint,

Above: An artist's rendering of how Ron Nunes's coupe will look when it hits the track.






This pickup had plenty of legroom but with the engine so far forward the radiator had to be moved under the bed.



Kent Keller brought his blown Chrysler '33 gasser down from Washington to battle with the big boys.




Mike Nordahl set up a booth and showed off his beautiful reproduction Willys parts.

BOB IDA #430 MORGANVILLE NJ




DON LENAKER #360 GRANDE TERRACE CA









Victor and I got to looking at the parts we had leftover from our coupe projects etc and discovered we could build a nostalgia drag car. We are partners in the body and chassis. I own the 301 Chevy engine and wheels while the B&M Turbo 400 racing trans' and Enderle fuel injection belong to Victor. Other features are chopped top, 5:57 Posi' Olds' rear end, 4' ladder bars, boxed chassis and droped tube axle. Total cost will be under \$1000. Body is from the old "Speed Engineering" gasser from Arizona. Truck is in the very early stages.








Jack's coupe is painted metallic maroon and sees about 200 miles per month. It's a steel body with 'glass front end, rear fenders and trunk lid. L-82 350 engine came out of a Corvette, it now features a healthy dose of chrome! TH 400 trans' has deep pan and shift kit. Rear end is 8 3/4" Dodge (3:91 Posi) mounted on leaf springs with traction bars and chrome wheelie bars. Mustang II front suspension features 2" dropped spindles. Centerline wheels have Spadaro knockoffs. Interior has Mustang seats. Trunk is also fully upholstered and carpeted.







JEFFERY REYNOLDS #460 BURBANK IL

Recognize this car? This is one of the cars used in "HOT ROD"/"REBEL OF THE ROAD" movie.Jeff is in the process of updating the car with Alston tube chassis with strut front end. Rear end is narrowed Dana 60. Car will be used for race only, engine is 377 Chevy with Brodix heads and much more. Full race Powerglide with trans' brake backs it up. Car was bought in San Jose, CA in 1980 and it was in fair shape. Price was \$5,200.










After buying the body shell for \$450, it only took 14 months and \$3,550 for Michael to have a running street rod. Michael handled all the work himself from engine building to paint job, a real feat these days! Stock frame is boxed, front suspension consists of chrome straight tube axle on leaf springs with gas shocks and Monte Carlo disc brakes. 12 bolt rear end has Moroso Posi' and 4:56 gears, it's mounted with coil springs, gas shocks and ladder bars. Hot 350 Chevy has forged pistons, solid lifters, roller rockers and 750 holley on tunnel m. 11" Zoom clutch & pressure plate lead to Muncie 4-speed with Hurst shifter. Interior . :tures '82 Courier bench seat, SW gauges, 4-point cage and Monza tilt column. Little red coupe cuts 11.81 quarter at 115mph.




GARY GALARDI #474 OAKDALE NY

Other features are custom radiator, Vega steering box, stock pedal ass' with GM master cyl', Corvette steering wheel and stock seats.

Stan has been working on this '41 coupe for 8 yrs now doing all the body, paint, suspenion work himself, he is currently putting in a gray mohair interior. 





FIRST RUN - - NO FUN!



Steve was on his first half pass in the car, he had just shifted and was getting off the gas when the car took a left turn, got on it's side and slid off the track and into the



guardrail. The car ended up on it's roof. Steve made it out without a scratch. Suspected cause is a combination of wind and oil on the track. The majority of damage was to the body but by the time you read this the car will be all repaired, good as new. Engine at the time was a 482" Big Block Chevy that had run 8's in a Camaro, car will be running a 560" engine in the NDRA "Super-Street" class.








