The Coupe was chopped 4", has a blown small block, 2 650 Holleys, Corvette rear, Nova front

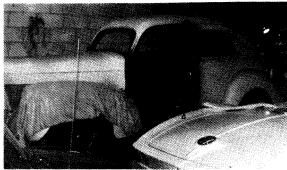
and grey & black interior.

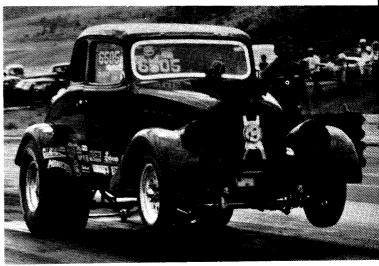
"OLD TIMER DRAGS", BRITISH COLUMBIA, CANADA.

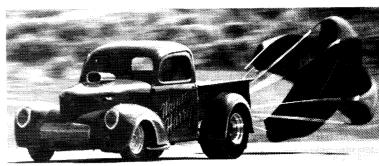


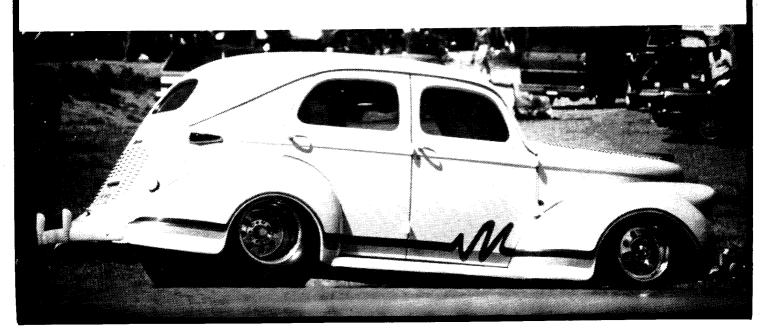

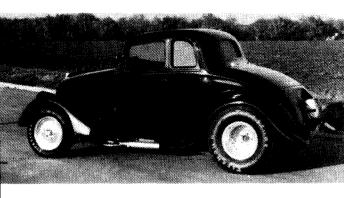


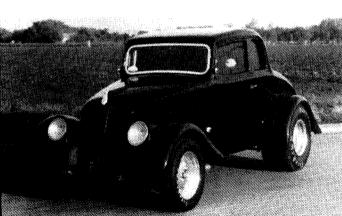












ART GUSTAFSON, #531 STOCKTON, CA.

I have wanted a Willys since I first started going to the drag races at Fremont and Half Moon Bay in Northern California. That was in 1962 when I was a teenager and now at the age of 43 and the owner of a wrecking vard in Stockton, California, my wish has come true.

The car is a '35 Coupe with '33 front end. It has a long drag racing history. The car started racing in the early '60's with a blown Olds' engine and belonged to the Warren, Miller, Warren team. Then it was sold to Tony Del Rio and made into an A/G car and then into an A/GS car with a blown big block Chevy engine.

After it's racing career it sat in different garages and was sold several times before I bought it

and put it back in racing condition.

I took the car to the nostalgia drags and went 11.30 @ 115mph and feel with a few changes it will go in the 10's next time out. Halibrand wheels are on order to keep the nostalgia look.

Front axle is a dropped tube axle with coil overs, four bars, Vega steering and JFZ discs.

Rear end is '57 Olds' (5:14 Posi), Henrys axles, drum brakes, coil springs and ladder bars.

Frame has been boxed, filled, ground smooth, round tube cross members installed then painted black Imron.

Engine is a 350 Chev with aluminum Bowtie heads, Edelbrock Victor Jr manifold,750 Holley, Engle roller cam, roller rockers, Mallory sprint mag' and chrome headers.

Transmission is a 400 Turbo w/manual valve body, deep oil pan, oil cooler, 4,500 stall speed, shifter is Turbo action and a TCI trans' shield.

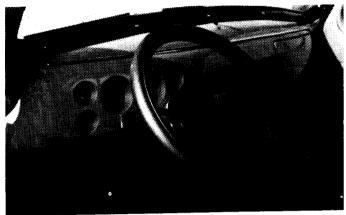
Floor and trunk are done in sheet aluminum. Inside the trunk you'll find a fuel cell w/two Holley fuel pumps. Tail lamps are Austin Healy.

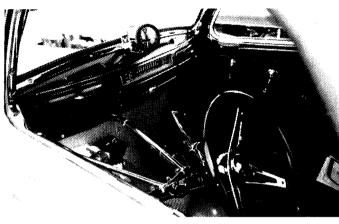
Interior has a roll cage, stock dash with SW gauges, fiberglass bucket seats and '34 Ford door handles.

The body is steel with a filled top. Doors are steel with operating black tinted glass. The fiberglass parts include rear fenders, deck lid and tilt front end. The car has original headlamps and hood emblem. The grille is handmade from 1/4" tubing and the firewall is polished stainless steel.

Mark has a super clean street rod here! Advark Orange Polyurethane covers steel cab and bed. Front clip, running boards and rear fenders are fiberglass. Boxed frame has Pinto IFS and marrowed 9" mounted on coil springs w/ladder bars. Power comes from a 429 Ford w/forged pistons, radical cam and dual quad tunnel ram. C4 trans' is used. Interior features a S-10 Blazer rear seat, Autometer gauges and Grant wheel.

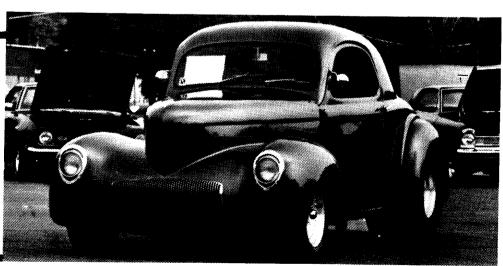


RICK WILLIAMSON, #444, WHITEROCK, BC, CANADA.

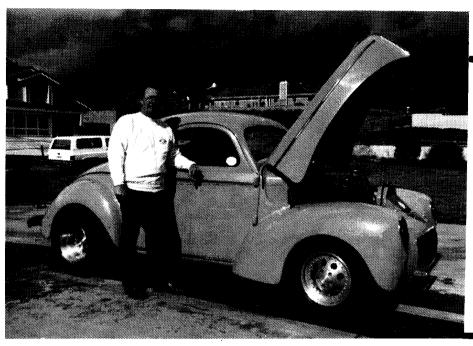

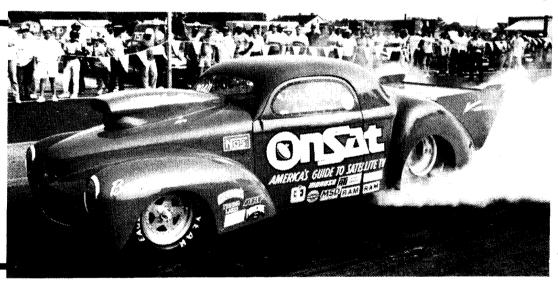


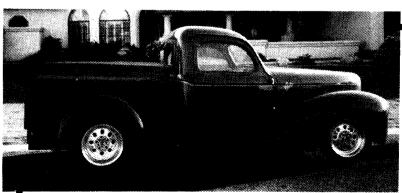
MIKE NORDAHL, #009 ALTA LOMA, CA

Truck also features a smooth custom dash, air conditioning, electric doors and polished stainless steel pickup bed floor.

JACK OLCOTT, #206, HOPEWELL JCT, NY.

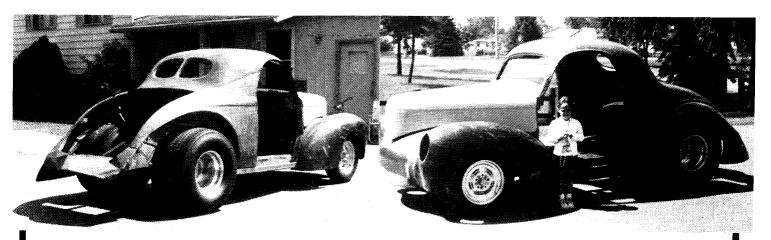

Tony bought this truck back in 1963 for\$125. It now has 283, Powerglide, and Pinto discs on Willys spindles. Truck is all steel apart from the 'glass dash and has a tilt/tele column.

Dereke plans to have his car done for Fall. It is progressing nicely. Latest purchase was an Outlaw pro-street chassis. When the project is completed it will have a blown 350 Chevy powerplant. Color will be purple, interior is yet undecided.



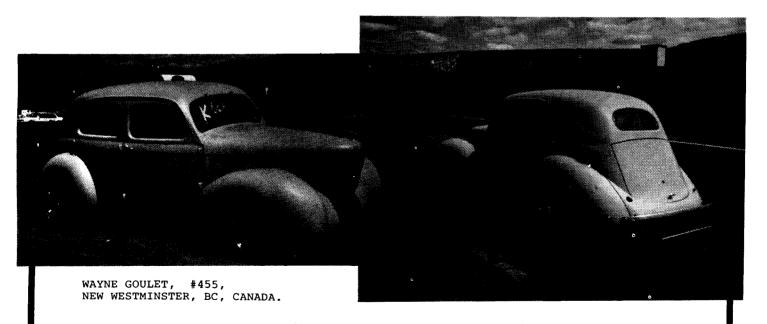
WOODY PARKER, #701, NAPA, CA.

Woody makes his living as an auto mechanic so turning wrenches on his Willys comes second nature to him.Pro-Street '40 features narrowed 9", triangulated 4 bars, Pinto IFS w/urethane bushings and will run a built 355ci small block w/6.71 Littlefield blower. Transmission will be a 350TH w/shift kit. Custom bodywork includes VW gas door in the rear 1/4 panel, filled drip rails, all side trim holes filled and 3rd brake light below rear window.



JAMES PECCI, #743 BEAVERCREEK, OH.

JP's bright red '41 is set up for nostalgia racing. It's powered by a 355 Chevy with 8qt pan, complete Crane valvetrain, ported heads and roller rockers. Induction consists of a 750 Holley on an Offy manifold. Tranny is a TH350 w/manual valve body. Detroit Locker (5:38 gears) is mounted on leaf springs w/ladder bars. Car runs 11.72 @ 113mph. Other features are Weld wheels, Autometer gauges and aluminum interior.



Wayne's Sedan is in primer here but is soon to be painted I.R.O.C. blue. This car is set up to run with it's 454 big block, Turbo 400 and narrowed 9" rear end w/4.88 gears. Firewall is aluminum as are the dash and floor pan. Other features are 10pt cage, 4 link and there are disc brakes on all 4 corners.

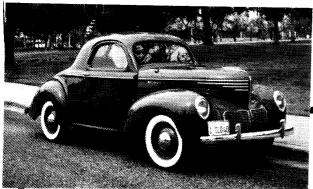
AL MAYNARD JR, #043 MT CLEMENS, MI.

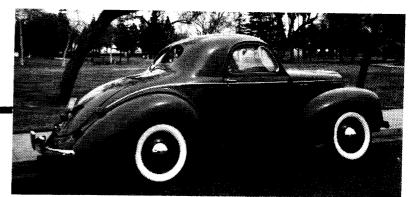

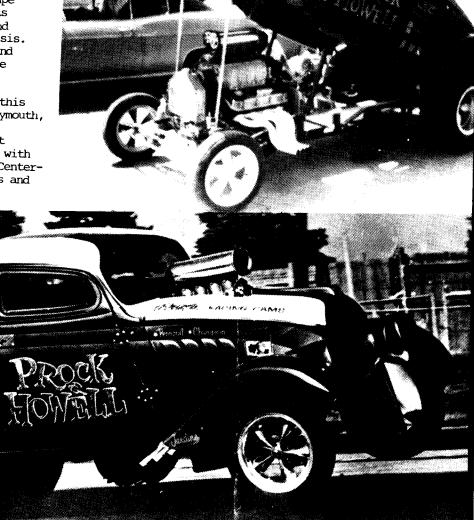


DAN LAU, #441, PLYMOUTH, WI.
