

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


## THU HRS TO THE








"You're right, dear... it is too big for the baby. Guess I'll have to drive it until he's old enough..."






### HOWARD FALVEY, #676 WOODLAND, CA


### JOHN P McLAUGHLIN, #480 LEOMINSTER, MA

John's '33 Coupe project is based on a Sheffler fiberglass body, the nose is an AI unit.Nostalgic engine is a 301 Chevy (punched out 283) with Jahns 11½-1 pistons,roller rockers,Manley cam and Edelbrock triple carb setup. Muncie 4-spd backs it up with narrowed 9" Ford rear end.2x3 tube chassis has Spax coil-overs and 4-bars out back and 4" dropped Bell tube axle, Posies transverse leaf spring and stainless 4-bars up front. Vega steering and Airheart disc brakes are used.




#### DAN GRUER, #466 QUEBEC, CANADA

Clyde Yokoi, #730,does a little tuning on his white '42 Coupe. Clyde is from Newberry Park, CA.




Stuart Schneider showed up with his mint green Sedan and orange Coupe with new blower motor.





### BRUCE FIENE, #395 STEELEVILLE, NY


### ROBERT SHARP, #681 MONROVIA, CA










DAVID TUCCI, #773 UTICA, NY






RICK LIST, #266 BERGEN, NY
















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### COUPE REAR PANEL UPDATE.

Just received a phone call from Custom Metal Shaping. The forming Jig has been completed and one panel has been made to figure the time/cost to make a panel. The project took longer than expected because of the back log of work at Custom Metal. Looks like the total cost of each panel will be and packing and shipping in the U.S.. Each panel will be formed using a Jig copied from an original panel. This will insure uniformity in each panel. Each panel will be formed using a Jig Each panel will have the flange on either side, and the rolled edge along at the bottom. They can be ordered either with or without the U shaped channel at the top, for the same price. The channel will be formed using the same engineering change in late '39. After '39, the panels had a heavier gage from an original panel is usable then I would suggest using it and ordering the panel without the channel attached and simply welding the original channel onto the new panel.

Once I have enough orders in hand I will have Custom Metal Shaping make the panels. The price was figured on them making ten panels all at the same time, not one off as orders come in. Depending on when this newsletter goes out and how fast I receive the orders will determine when they are finished. I'm hoping by the end of June. After this first batch of panels are made, it might be some time before more panels are made. If you think you might need one in the future, I suggest ordering now. Make checks payable to Jim Frank. 




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
