


COVER--Mike Nordahl shows us what great Christmas gifts his "Willys Replacement Parts" make.

Since joining the W.C.W.C. and sending in my first letter about my '36 pick-up, I have aquired a second Willys, a 1936 4 door sedan. After aquiring my pick-up I started looking for leads in Willys parts. A year ago I heard about a Willys at a local Rod Shop, Norm Francis Street Rods. Norm had picked up a 1936 Willys sedan so I went over to look at it. He said it wasn't for sale and he was going to make a drag car out of it sometime.

About a week ago a gal in my carclub came in and said Norm had a Willys coupe for sale, for \$100.00. The next day I phoned, he said it was the 4 door not the coupe and he had to get rid of it this weekend. I told him I would buy it. I am in the process of putting up a new garage so I didn't have a place to store it so I phoned a friend to ask if I could store it at his place, he said yes. When I told Norm I would buy the car he said it was a basket case and he hadn't touched it since he aquired it. Also he said he would deliver it. I hadn't seen it for over a year and really didn't look at it that good then because it wasn't for sale.

Norm came over to my house Saturday morning with the 4 door on the trailer. All the front sheetmetal was inside the car, no wheels on front and a Pinto rear end.

I looked at it a little and put some front wheels on it. It still has the original motor and trans in it. Norm was in a hurry so we went to my friend, Max's house to unload the Willys. The next day I went back to Max's house to find out what I had really bought. The 4 door is fairly solid but has surface rust, after unloading the inside of the car, everything is there, missing only a hood half, spare tire cover, grille insert, other than that it is complete and all steel for \$100.00.

I got the WD40 out and got the doors to open and shut, also the vent and the window risers to do the same.

I plan on putting in a Ford rear end and a Chevy II 4 cycle motor or small block with automatic and make a family cruiser to go with my p/u drag car.


Mikes parts are of the highest quality and they arrive ready to bolt on. No detailing or modifications are needed, they all look and fit just like the originals.


Mike has worked in casting and die-making for twenty years, his experience and the pride he takes in his work show through in his parts. Hundreds of satisfied customers can't be wrong!







Mike has been working on this '41 coupe, on and off, for 10 years. Fresh yellow paint, (1980 Corvette yellow) has 2 coats of clear with gold Murano. .060 over 327 is used with Turbo 400. Car is all steel apart from rear fenders. Willys Replacement Parts are used on both of Mikes coupes.

Latest items are these '33-'36 headlight rings and lenses, the lenses are made of heat resistant, durable polyester plastic. They look the same as the originals and have added bonus of being legal for drag cars where glass ones sometimes aren't.











'41/'42 grilles (above) and '40 grilles (left) are made of 356 Alloy Aluminum, polished and plated. When you buy "Willys Replacement Parts" you save yourself the time and money involved in making an old grille look like a brand new one, not to mention the hassle you can run into when dealing with some chrome shops.

Mike built his '40 coupe in the early '70's and raced it up 'til 1980. It is an NHRA legal E/Gasser. Car has 'glass hood and front fenders, 302 Chevy mill is built to the hilt by Mike himself who has also been known to build a race engine or two in his spare time. Super 'T-10 4-speed hooks up to 1-ton Chevy (6:17) rear end. car runs 10.20's @ 136 mph.



Rocky is putting in alot of hours on his '33 coupe. The chassis is completely hand built from 3/16 plate, bent, mitered and welded by Rocky. Crossmembers are made from stainless steel. Super Bell axle is used with 4-bars, steering box is Vega. Interior features '83 Trans Am tilt column and '85 Fiero buckets. Blown 350 produces 750 horsepower! It's backed up by a fully manual Turbo 400 and a narrowed 9". Rocky also has a 86 Corvette engine for long distance cruising.




JOHN BOTTONE #123 NORTH PLAINFIELD NJ








JOHN MEDRANO #146 SAN ANTONIO TX

streets in the summer of '87.








DAVE BEAUBIEN #114 WESTLAND MI

Engine is all aluminum 350 Chevy, (Donovan block and Brodix heads) with steel crank and TRW 11:1 pistons. Trans is Turbo 400 with 10" super hole shot converter and Hurst auto stick shifter. Rear end is narrowed 9" with 4:86 gears and '67 Mustang disc's. Complete chassis was hand built by Dave. Truck is currently apart for bodywork and paint.

David is building this pick-up for friend Tom Riem. It is all steel apart from A-I 'glass rear fenders. B&M blown 350 Chevy powers the truck. Halibrand wheels are used all 'round, paint will be yellow arcrylic enamel. 


ROD WELTZ #136 OAKLAND CA





ROB GILES #030 WOODINVILLE WA
